Why is this training course more desirable than the others?



What will the certification allow you to do?

The successful completion of the training course is followed by an exam. If you pass the exam, you can apply for the "PECB Certified ISO 37001 Lead Auditor" credential. An **IAS accredited** and internationally recognized "PECB ISO 37001 Lead Auditor" certificate validates your professional capabilities and demonstrates your ability to audit an ABMS based on ISO 37001.

Certification is the formal recognition and proof of knowledge which carries an important weight when you are entering the labor market, or when you want to advance in your career. A certified ABMS auditor will be able to audit an ABMS, serve as an audit team leader, or provide consultancy services in some cases for the improvement of the ABMS.


